Living in Wainyapu feels like stepping back one hundred years.

There is no electricity, no running water, and cooking is done outside or in a big fire lit in the middle of the *rumah*. The traditional houses are constructed from unusual and striking wooden structures, built around four pillars that support a high roof covered in Alang grass, and a bamboo floor separates the each family's living area from the underground stable for their animals. Houses are often aligned around a yard dotted with tombstones and sacrificial altars where ceremonies are carried out.

After photographing in and around the village for a few days, I paid a visit to the beach close by and met some kids who were longing to show off their riding skills. The horses that fight each year during the Pasola festival are small by European standards, yet are well suited for the ceremonial battle due to their strength and resistance.
